

QUICK GUIDE Unfolding the eFOLDi Lite Scooter

Before starting stand the scooter upright in an open space away from pets and small children.

Unfolding the scooter is straightforward and with a little practice you will be able to set it up in seconds.

We advise you to practise with the scooter before venturing out for the first time.












Release the yellow steering column latch....

2 ...and allow the column to swing free.

Pull the handlebars out and upward..







Locate small yellow toggle on side and pull to release front wheel assembly.



Hold the steering column and seat back and pull them apart...



...the scooter will unfold as you pull the seat back and steering column apart and ...



...the scooter will lock itself into its open position.



Make sure the locking latches have locked to the steel bar...



...if not press your foot down onto the footplate to lock the scooter open.



If not already installed apply the seat cushions and seat back as shown.



Check that the magnetic brake is in the LOCKED position to engage the motor.

Folding the eFOLDi Lite Scooter



Fold the seat backrest down to the seat base.



If the scooter has armrests pull the black toggle to release then fold backrest down as per (1)



Press and hold the small yellow latch on the steering column...



...and fold the column down until it is locked by the magnetic catch.



Firmly hold the scooter by its steering column and the carry handle and firmly press the column down towards the footplate

Tip the scooter back at an angle and use your foot behind the wheel to stop it moving away from you

..press inwards on the steering column until the front wheel locks into place...



...and the steering column latch locks into position.



Press in steering column to lock it tightly against the frame.

eFOLDi Lite Operation



To turn the scooter on press the grey button below the battery display.

Select (D) Drive or (R) Reverse and press the thumb throttle to go.



The battery can be charged using the charging port as shown.

Always recharge the battery as soon as possible when the display is indicating amber.



The battery can be removed by lifting the latch and lifting the battery upwards.

After removal the battery can be charged using the socket on the side of the battery.
